PART I – CLARIFICATIONS

- 1. <u>Proposal Bid Items to be Submitted</u> In accordance with the Contract Documents, the following items are to be submitted as part of the bidder's proposal:
 - Bid Form (3 pages)
 - Bidder Status Form (2 pages)
 - Bid Bond (1 page)

Submission of bidding documents shall be in *separate, sealed envelopes* as follows:

- <u>Bid Opening Location</u> The bid opening will be held in person at HR Green's Office at 5525 Merle Hay Rd, Suite 200, Johnston, IA 50131. Contractors may mail their bids or hand deliver to this location.
- <u>No American Iron and Steel Requirements (AIS)</u> This project is <u>not</u> subject to any AIS requirements or prevailing wage rates. Imported materials are allowed if they meet specifications.
- 4. <u>Planholder's List</u> See attached planholder's list.
- Permits Contractor shall obtain an electrical permit through the Iowa Department of Public Safety. Steve Nisser is the State Electrical Inspector for the project area and can be contacted at 515-210-7294 or <u>nisser@dps.state.ia.us</u>. No other permits are anticipated to be required.

- 6. <u>Project OPCC</u> The Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost is \$1,750,000.00.
- 7. <u>Project Sign</u> A project sign is not required at the new tank site.
- 8. <u>Tank Logo</u> No tank logo is included in the scope of work.

PART II – SPECIFICATIONS

9. <u>Section 00520, Page 1, Article 2, Contract Times</u> – Delete the subparagraph under Article 2 in its entirety and replace with the following:

"With Notice to Proceed no later than <u>May 30, 2022</u>, all portions of Work shall be substantially completed and operational on or before <u>June 30, 2023</u>, and shall be fully completed on or before <u>September 15, 2023</u>, subject to any extension of time, which may be granted by the Owner."

- 10. <u>Section 00800, Page 8, Article SGC-7.01.F</u> Replace the existing Article F with the following:
 - "F. Except in connection with safety or protection of persons or Work or property at site or adjacent thereto, and except as otherwise indicated in Contract Documents, all Work at site shall be performed during regular working hours. Contractor may perform work on Saturday and Sunday as long as work does not require special inspection by Owner and does not create excessive noise. Contractor shall not permit overtime work on any legal holiday without Owner's written consent given after prior written notice to Engineer. Workmanship shall be of best quality."
- 11. <u>Section 00800, Page 11, Article SGC-15.03.G</u> Add the following subparagraph to the end of Article SGC-15.03.G:


"Completion of site work not critical to the operation of the elevated water storage tank and completion of the demolition of the existing standpipe and associated foundation are <u>not</u> required to be completed to be considered substantially complete."

- 12. <u>Section 01 1000, Page 2, Article 1.09.D.1</u> Replace the existing Article 1 with the following:
 - "1. Limit conduct of especially noisy exterior work to the hours of 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday thru Friday and 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturday and Sunday, unless given approval by Owner."

13. <u>Sheet E2, Detail 4, Notes</u> – Add the following note:

- "2. The following luminaire manufacturers are acceptable alternatives to those specified in the LUMINAIRES schedule:
 - Type 4A: Gardco Lighting
